SERMON NOTES...

James 4:13-17

"13 Now listen, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money." 14 Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. 15 Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." 16 As it is, you boast and brag. All such boasting is evil. 17 Anyone, then, who knows the good he ought to do and doesn't do it, sins."

Opening Responsive Reading

LEADER: As we enter this festive time of worship, we trade the songs of darkness for a melody of light, we trade the songs of self for a tune of praise, we trade our downward glances for heavenward adoration.

PEOPLE: God is putting us back together, so we come singing joyfully. God has lifted us up, so we come praising. Delight is our fitting response.

LEADER: So play skillfully, musicians! Shout for joy, young and old! Make music and sing a new song, all you people!

PEOPLE: Praise the LORD! His grace has given us a new song to sing.

LEADER: As we enter this refreshing time of hearing God's Word, we realize that we have spoken hurtful words into this world and we have had harmful words spoken to us.

PEOPLE: So we come to have the powerful Word of the LORD spoken over us, in us, and through us.

LEADER: God spoke and the heavens were made, the stars and planets of the universe were made by the breath of his mouth. God's voice controls the waters of the sea, the storms in the air, and puts all things in their appointed places and seasons.

PEOPLE: He spoke and it came to be; he commanded and it stood firm.

LEADER: So let God speak over us today, let his word and spirit rearrange us into his new creation people. Let his mighty voice reconstitute us into spokespeople for his Kingdom. Let his word invigorate us and commission us to speak peace to the nations.
