WILL YOU PARTICIPATE IN OUR 2021 THANKSGIVING STUFFING CHALLENGE?


All throughout the month of October, we will be collecting boxes of stuffing. Our goal as a church is to collect 1000 boxes! These boxes will be donated to Open Access who
