CHURCH LIFE...

COMMITTEE HIGHLIGHT: Meet the First Responders. Every Sunday, a member of our church who is trained in emergency response is designated to help out if there is a medical need during our time together. The First Responders team is prepared to alert this volunteer when help is needed. Meanwhile, a team of deacons and other volunteers monitor our building entrances during the service. NOTE: The First Responders will lock all entrances except the front (east-facing) doors at 9:45am. The Family Life entrance (nursery door) will be locked as the service begins. If you show up after the service begins, the front doors will always be open.

THIS YEAR we are again partnering with Chicagoland Prison Outreach in the Angels of Hope Christmas project. The Angel Tree is in the Fellowship Hall now with tags on it for Christmas gifts for children of inmates. Take an angel from the tree and PRINT your name and phone# on the angel list on the table. Buy the gift listed on your angel and return it by Wednesday, December 1. On your gift attach the angel (use it for the name tag and you can put your name as giver if you like.) Wrap the gift as securely as possible as it is handled many times getting to its destination. Please spend a minimum of \$10.00 on your gift as this may be the only present your "angel" will receive. If you are uncomfortable or cannot make it in to get a tag from the tree, please call Noreen (708-752-6706) and she will let you know what is available to pick from. Also, some gifts requested are expensive (ex. coats) so feel free to go together with another family. Thank you.

- Friday, December 24, join us for our **Christmas Eve Service** at 11:00pm. This service is always a highlight of the year, as we stay up and greet Christmas Day with carols, candlelight, bells, and worship.
