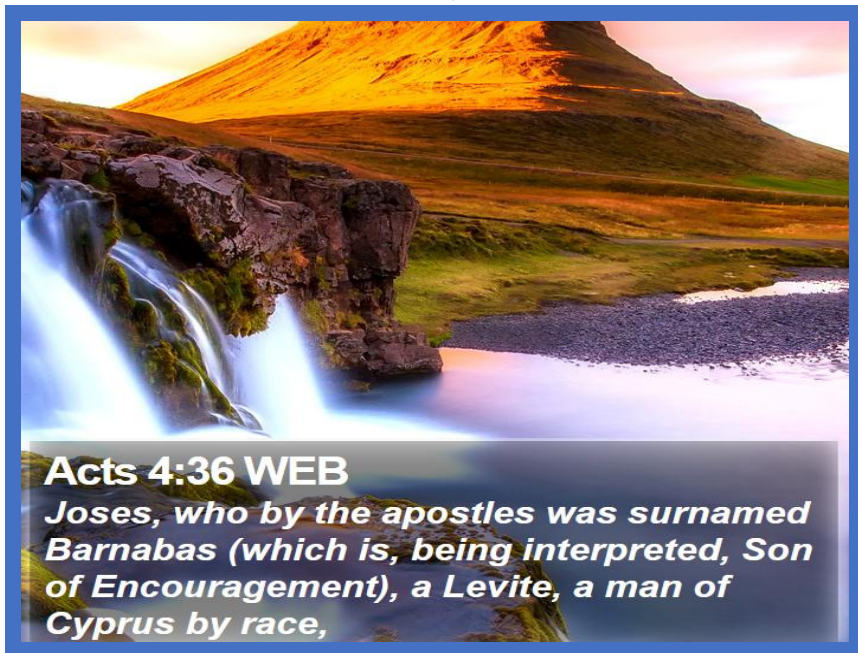

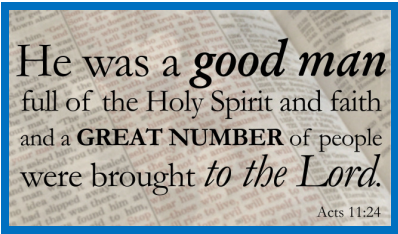
VISIT THE WELCOME CENTER in the narthex to sign cards for our shut-ins and hospitalized.
