Today is Christ the King Sunday, which is the last Sunday of the church calendar (the new year begins with Advent next Sunday).

Christ the King Sunday is a time to recommit ourselves to Kingdom living, walking into a new year as followers of Jesus. This Sunday invites us to reimagine all of life with Jesus at the center. Interestingly, Christ the King Sunday wasn't added to the church calendar until 1925. The first Christ the King Sunday was celebrated in Italy as an act of opposition to the teachings of fascism, supremacy, and nationalism that had gripped that country under Mussolini.

As we celebrate today, we're joined by the minor prophet Zechariah, who invites us to reimagine our world under the Kingship of Christ. Among the southern windows of our sanctuary, Zechariah is represented with a winged scroll, a symbol from his dream in Zechariah 5:1-2.
