Welcome to First Reformed Church!

We are currently observing the season of Advent, the four weeks leading up to Christmas. The word "Advent" means "coming" or "arrival;" it is a period of preparation as the church lives in expectation and hope for the coming of Jesus.

This year, we are going to be placing ourselves in the shoes (or sandals) of God's people in the Old Testament, waiting for the coming Christ with the minor prophets. The stained-glass windows on the southern wall of the sanctuary use symbols representing the four major prophets (window by the piano) and twelve minor prophets.

Today's window represents the prophet Habakkuk using the symbol of the temple, recalling Habakkuk's call to worship.


VISIT THE WELCOME CENTER in the narthex to sign cards for our shut-ins and hospitalized.
