PROCEDURE FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTS: Absentee ballots (also available in the church office) should be placed in a sealed envelope with the eligible voting church member's signature and the date on the outside and delivered to the church office prior to the meeting of May 13. Please note that voting will be by slate (collectively) for each office. Therefore, there may be one vote of "yes" or "no" for Elders, the same for Deacons and Trustees. So absentee ballots are for elder, deacon, and trustee only! Voting on denominational direction will be by paper ballot and requires a 2/3 majority of those present. You must be present at the meeting to vote on denominational direction.


