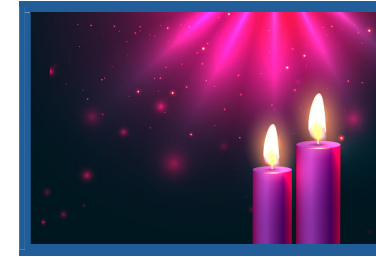
SERMON NOTES...
