Today is the first Sunday of "Ordinary Time" according to the liturgical calendar of the Church. Ordinary Time comprises two periods: the first period begins on Epiphany Day or the day after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord and ends on the day before Ash Wednesday; the second period begins on the Monday after Trinity Sunday and continues until the Saturday before Christ The King Sunday. In some traditions, the first period is celebrated as Epiphanytide and the latter of these periods is observed as Trinitytide. Both of these periods of time, combined, are the longest time in the liturgical year. The liturgical color for this season is Green and is marked by a time of spiritual maturity and growth.
